2010 Graduate Fellowships
Proposal Deadline: Monday, March 8, 2010

The Hudson River Foundation will award up to four full-time research fellowships in 2010 to advanced graduate students conducting research on the Hudson River system.

Fellowships awarded to doctoral students will consist of a stipend of up to \$15,000 for one year, and an incidentals research budget not to exceed \$1,000. Fellowships awarded to master's level students will include a stipend of up to \$11,000 for one year and an incidentals research budget of up to \$1,000. *The award is conditional upon a full tuition waiver or reimbursement by the student's graduate institution.*

Applicants must be enrolled in an accredited program, must have a thesis advisor and advisory committee (if appropriate to the institution), and must have a thesis research plan approved by the student's institution. *The student's home university will be expected to be the primary source of support for materials and expenses required to do the thesis research, and will also be expected to cover any indirect costs associated with the project.*

Application procedures and necessary forms can be obtained at www.hudsonriver.org.

Applications must include 1) an HRF Proposal Cover Page, 2) student's curriculum vitae, 3) a description of the project, 4) a timetable, 5) an estimate of the cost of supplies, travel, etc., and 6) a letter from the university stating that the student will receive a tuition waiver or reimbursement for the period of the fellowship.

Two letters of recommendation, sent under separate cover, are also required; one must be from the student's advisor and should certify the student's current status, evaluate the student's capabilities, and rate the student's project on technical merit.

Applications, in one electronic pdf format file (except for letters of recommendation), must be received by the Foundation at info@hudsonriver.org by 5:00 p.m., Monday, March 8, 2010. The e-mail subject heading should read "Graduate Fellowship Submittal." In addition, a hard-copy original postmarked no later than Monday, March 8, 2010, must be sent to: Hudson River Foundation, Graduate Fellowship Committee, 17 Battery Place, Suite 915, New York, New York. Decisions will be made by June 30, 2010.
