- Tina Walsh of Hudson River Park Trust spoke about SUBMERGE 2023 and how it brought together a number of representatives from Gov't and NGOs across the estuary as well as participants of all ages to learn about marine science while using the Hudson River as a resource.
- Tina connected a lot of the programming back to fostering public understanding, one of the major goals of HEP's action agenda.
- SUBMERGE collaborated with more 100 partner organizations. An example of such partnerships include, Bronx River Alliance whose work also meets a lot of the objectives of the Bronx/Harlem Urban Waters Federal Partnership location
- Questions:
  - Chris G- could you talk a little bit about HRP's connection with DEC and what you've
    done to include their priorities in yours? Tina Because we're a state public authority,
    this really drives our connection to DEC. Carrie it's an opportunity for our partners to

- come together and creating more intentional spaces to help with the exchange of information.
- Wynnie I read the other day there's going to be a beach is this the same area? Tina Yes it's in the south side of the space. Not a swimming beach but it is a beach for
  lounging and open recreation and features a kayak launch. Due to the soft sloping
  shoreline it allows for the spark of new interesting recreation opportunities.
- Dave: very interesting work and wondering if this could be something that gets brought to other places in the estuary as well.
